


Description: The field survey was conducted using standard archaeological procedures and techniques. For the most part, in the northern half of the parcel, continuous parallel transects (20 meters) were walked in an east/west direction. Survey conditions in these areas were very good; the parcel is almost completely barren with the exception of a large willow tree in the

central portion of the proposed lot 2, and a portion of native vegetation in the northwest corner. A single-family residence has already been constructed in the proposed parcel 1, adjacent to Cedar Street. No bedrock outcrops or stream beds were observed within the project area. No artifacts or features were identified during this survey. This project proposes to subdivide 4.28 acres into two residential lots.

Prior Research: Staff conducted a records search of the surrounding area using the California Historic Resources Inventory System (CHRIS). Thirty studies (30) have been conducted within a one mile radius and 19 sites were identified.

Native American Consultation: No Sacred Lands were identified by the Native American Heritage Commission (NAHC). Staff contacted the Native American groups and individuals provided by the NAHC to further investigate whether they have knowledge of Sacred Lands occurring on the subject parcels. Because the project consists of a GPA (General Plan Amendment), the tribal letter included a request for consultation pursuant to SB 18. No tribal response was received as of this report date.
