1. **Call to Order:** Jean Strouf called the meeting to order at 7:31 p.m.

2. **Roll Call:** Jean Strouf, Elizabeth Kelly, Dan Neirinckx, Dan Kjonegaard, Preston Brown, Randy White, Bill Herde, Ray Deitchman, Janet Mulder, Michael Casinelli, and Earl Katzer.
Excused: Judy Bohlen, Joan Kouns, and Steve Wragg.
Absent: Yvonne Purdy-Luxton.

3. Motion to approve the Agenda August 27, 2013, as posted 72 hours before the meeting and the minutes of August 13, 2013 as corrected with thanks to Dan Kjonegaard for taking the notes in Janet's absence. Motion carried unanimously.

4. **Open Forum: Opportunity for members of the public to speak on any item not on the agenda (time limit 3 minutes)**
 - a. **Bill Herde has not heard back from the car wash "car sales" – we have heard complaints, but they are working on a permit.**
 - b. **Jean Strouf PDLO funds have the athletic fields as our number one priority and the JDCPG received a notice of a fundraiser put on by the AYSO Soccer**
 - c. – **Randy White announced that the fundraiser will be held at Pio Pico Park Sept. 15 – 3-7 – NRG Band will entertain. Food donated from our local restaurants and tickets are on sale through the jacjamul website at \$20 - \$25 a the door.**
 - d. **Janet Mulder will not be at the next meeting. Dan Kjonegaard graciously agreed to take the notes of the meeting and get to Janet to do the minutes.**

5. **STEELE CANYON HIGH SCHOOL PRESENTATION ON HEALTH & SAFETY ISSUE – Jean Strouf spoke with the Business Manager, Jennifer Nerat, and asked why they had not come to our last meeting when they were on the agenda. She was told that the Business Manager had been told by someone present at the meeting that the proposed project does not fall within our Jamul Dulzura Planning Area and that they would probably not be given more of our PLDO funds.**
Dan Kjonegaard pointed out that Steele Canyon High School needs to go to Valle De Oro Planning Group before they come to us. Jean Strouf stated that she is working on a pathway for equestrian traffic and suggested that Steele Canyon could work with Supervisor Jacob to see if they could not work out a co-mingled trail of equestrian and pedestrian traffic. Earl Katzer pointed out that there needs to be safer sidewalks

throughout Jamul and he would personally like to see them be asphalt rather than decomposed granite.

6. JAMUL INDIAN VILLAGE UPDATE – Nothing to report except the fundraiser on Sept. 15 at Pio Pico from 3-7.

7. JDCPG Officers Announcements and Reports

a. Jean Strouf announced that there was no mail.

b. She listed the activities she had completed including following through on the PLDO priority list which she sent to Bill Saumier, SD County; sent our recommendation to Kenton Jones, DPW, regarding the signs and banners in right of way and that we recommended it be adopted as presented; and she sent the Arco AM/PM letter to Maritza Gonzalez of ABC, recommending our approval of the Condition #9 on the license selling of the smaller containers.
