


MAINE AVENUE UTILITY UNDERGROUNDING PROJECT

Project Description and Purpose

The Maine Avenue Utility Undergrounding project will convert existing electric, telephone and cable television lines from overhead to underground on Maine Avenue, between Woodside Avenue and Mapleview Street. The objectives of the project are to improve the appearance of the Maine Avenue streetscape, reduce the fire threat from overhead lines and eliminate sidewalk obstacles for pedestrians and vehicles. This is a partnership project between the County of San Diego and San Diego Gas and Electric Company.

Project Benefits

The Maine Avenue project provides the following benefits:

- Convert 52 property services to underground
- Remove 36 utility poles
- Improve Maine Avenue streetscape
- Reduce fire threat from overhead lines

Project Funding

The estimated construction cost of the project is estimated at \$1.3 million and will be funded by SDG&E's 20A funds collected through electric customer billings, AT&T Rule 32A funds and funds from other overhead utility providers.

Construction Schedule

Utility crews from SDG&E, AT&T and Cox are continuing to pull cable at various locations within the project area. Parking and traffic should not be impacted.
