WEEKLY H1N1 UPDATE

There are no additional H1N1-related deaths to report. San Diego County has had 820 hospitalized cases of H1N1 to date.

The San Diego County Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA) vaccinated nearly 5,000 people at H1N1 mass vaccination events held at Qualcomm Stadium and in Escondido last weekend.

“We are still not out of the woods. The virus is still present throughout our community,” said Wilma Wooten, M.D., M.P.H, San Diego County Public Health Officer. “While many people have gotten vaccinated, there are still many more who have yet to get the vaccine. The vaccine is now widely available.”
