## **NOT TOO LATE TO VACCINATE** *County Offers No-Cost H1N1 Vaccine to All*

The San Diego County Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA) will hold an H1N1 vaccination event for San Diego County residents at The Center on Wednesday, February 10, 2010 from 3:00-7:00 p.m.

The Center is located at 3909 Centre Street, San Diego, CA 92103. The vaccine is free and available to anyone six months and older.

“It’s not too late to protect yourself against H1N1,” said Wilma Wooten, M.D., M.P.H, San Diego County Public Health Officer. “We encourage everyone to get vaccinated as there could be another wave of H1N1 disease in the weeks or months to come.”

HHSA continues to offer the H1N1 vaccine at six Public Health Centers and one Immunization Clinic. You should contact your medical provider about getting the H1N1 flu vaccine. If your medical provider does not have vaccine, or you do not have a regular medical provider, you can call 2-1-1 or visit [www.sdcountry.ca.gov](http://www.sdcountry.ca.gov) to learn where you can get vaccinated.

Furthermore, many community health centers throughout the region offer the H1N1 vaccine at no cost to the general public during extended hours.
