## **INITIAL H1N1 VACCINE SHOTS ARRIVE** *Additional Doses Expected in Coming Weeks*

- WHAT:** The second allotment of H1N1 vaccine has arrived in San Diego County. Chairwoman Dianne Jacob and Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA) officials will announce distribution plans and answer questions from the media.

- INFO:** The second allotment of H1N1 vaccine received by the County consists of pediatric and adult doses of injections and nasal spray. The vaccine will be administered at the County's six public health centers and one vaccination clinic. Additional doses are going to hospitals, community clinics and to healthcare emergency workers.
- Public health facilities will be open on Saturday and Sunday from 9:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. to administer H1N1 vaccine. Locations of Public Health Centers can be found at [www.sdiz.org](http://www.sdiz.org) or by calling 2-1-1.
- You are encouraged to call your primary care provider to get an H1N1 vaccine. If your primary care provider did not order vaccine or you do not have a primary care doctor, H1N1 vaccine can be obtained at a County public health center.
