

# California's Coordinated Care Initiative



## WHO

### Consumers

- Seniors and Persons with Disabilities who receive Medi-Cal benefits **ONLY**
- People who receive benefits from **BOTH** Medicare & Medi-Cal

### Health Plan Options in San Diego County

- Care1st Health Plan, Community Health Group, Health Net, & Molina Healthcare will offer Cal MediConnect plans that will cover **BOTH** Medicare & Medi-Cal benefits
- Plans listed above and Kaiser Permanente offer a Medi-Cal **ONLY** plan
- Program of All-inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) - eligibility requirements apply

## WHAT

### Benefits to Consumers

- Your Medicare & Medi-Cal can work together to provide coordinated care
- Your Long Term Services & Supports (LTSS) will be a health plan benefit

### LTSS includes:

- In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS)
- Skilled Nursing Facilities (SNF)
- Community-Based Adult Services (CBAS)
- Multi-purpose Senior Services Program (MSSP)

### Consumer Choices

- If you have Medi-Cal **ONLY** then you **MUST** choose a Medi-Cal managed care plan to receive your benefits which will include LTSS listed above
- If you have **BOTH** Medicare & Medi-Cal then you **MUST** choose **ONE** of the following:
  1. A Cal MediConnect Plan -Your Medicare & Medi-Cal benefits, including LTSS, will be covered by one plan. These plans will also provide vision, transportation, and care coordination benefits. Additional benefits **MAY** also be offered.
  2. PACE - Covers Medicare & Medi-Cal benefits for individuals who qualify.
  3. Keep your Medicare benefit as it is today, however you **MUST** still choose a Medi-Cal managed care plan for your Medi-Cal and LTSS benefits.

## WHEN

- Cal MediConnect will begin April 2014
- Medi-Cal Managed Care enrollment will occur in phases beginning April 2014
