Please join us on **Monday, May 3, 2010 from 10:30 AM to 12:00 PM** for our Quarterly LTCIP Stakeholder Meeting. The meeting will be held in the **San Diego Conference Room** at the **County's Health Services Complex, 3851 Rosecrans St., San Diego, 92110.**

With the passing of the Health Reform Bill and the State's efforts under the 1115 Waiver Renewal to improve service delivery while reducing the Medicaid expenditures for seniors and persons with disabilities, there are new opportunities for improving the complex and fragmented system of care that exists today. Come hear about those opportunities and receive updates on the LTCIP's three strategies: the Aging & Disability Resource Connection (ADRC), the fully integrated managed care model, and TEAM SAN DIEGO.

Dr. Mark Meiners will provide an update on health reform and discuss the impact of this legislation on seniors and persons with disabilities, as well as provide an update on TEAM SAN DIEGO. Sharon Cordice, Program Manager for Aging & Independence Services (AIS), will introduce a new ADRC Care Transitions Grant Program creating a partnership between AIS and Sharp Memorial Hospital that will reduce rehospitalizations for high-risk patients with chronic conditions. Floyd Willis, Executive Assistant to the AIS Director, will present information about a second ADRC grant that provides outreach, education and enrollment assistance with Medicare "Extra Help" Programs: the Low Income Subsidy and the Medicare Savings Plan.
