Medical Updates Regarding the Fires

- Remaining medically fragile evacuees at the Del Mar Fair Grounds shelter are in the process of being evacuated to various skilled nursing centers in Orange County.
- All hospital emergency departments have beds available for patients. As mentioned previously, Fallbrook and Pomerado hospitals are closed.
- The UCSD burn unit has available beds.
- All Community Clinics are available to receive patients.
- Medical Reserve Corps (MRC) volunteers are currently providing assistance at county shelters, such as Qualcomm Stadium, Sharp Cabrillo Hospital and the Del Mar Fairgrounds. Yesterday, the pharmacy emergency response team was activated. These persons are volunteer pharmacists and pharmacy technicians. **Important:** All facilities and locations receiving MRC volunteers need to verify his or her professional license and picture identification.
