Countywide Bioterrorism Drill on March 8 & 9, 2007

A countywide bioterrorism drill involving simulated mass prophylaxis will take place next week, Thursday and Friday, March 8 and 9, 2007. Drill objectives include simulating activation of the Strategic National Stockpile (SNS) and evaluating point of dispensing (POD) processes.

No action is expected or required from most EMAN participants. If you are scheduled to receive EMAN alerts related to the drill on March 8 & 9, you will be notified separately via EMAN in preparation for the drill.

Drill participants will include various County health and safety response groups, personnel, and programs, as well as Emergency Operations Center (EOC) staff from local hospitals.
