Notes:

- "Age-specific birth rates" are the number of live births to women in an age group per 1,000 population of women in that same age group.
- Births to women older than 49 are included in the 45-49 age group but birth rates are calculated using the population aged 45-49.
- The "general fertility rate" is the number of live births to females of all ages per 1,000 population of females aged 15 through 44 years.
- The "total fertility rate" is an estimate of the number of births that 1,000 women would have over their lifetimes, if they gave birth according to the age-specific birth rates in a specified year.

*Numbers are censored and rates are not calculated when the number of events is fewer than 5 (indicated by "<5"). Interpret with caution rates calculated for fewer than 20 events since they are considered statistically unreliable.
