LOW INCOME HEALTH PROGRAM (LIHP)

- The stakeholder meetings continue in order to gather input regarding future program changes. The next LIHP Stakeholder meeting is scheduled for 10/18/12.
- The County continues to host a monthly conference call with providers and stakeholders to discuss LIHP technical enrollment and eligibility issues.
- The CalWIN consortium continues to work on adding LIHP eligibility determination capability to CalWIN, the automated eligibility system for CalWORKs, CalFresh and Medi-Cal. San Diego is working with its IT vendors to prepare transitioning LIHP eligibility from the existing eligibility system to CalWIN, and to ensure the local systems continue to receive necessary eligibility information to process treatment referrals. The target date for completion of this CalWIN project is mid-October 2012, however, San Diego will delay using CalWIN for LIHP eligibility until the local systems have been modified to ensure continuity of care.
- To date, San Diego has received 273 referrals from the California Department of Health Care Services for State prisoners who are eligible for LIHP.
- As of September 30, 2012, Medi-Cal Access Support Unit (MASU) Social Workers (SWs) have assisted 110 AB 109 Post Release Offenders (PROs) with accessing health coverage. Twenty-nine (29) of these PROs were assisted with both LIHP and Medi-Cal Disability Determination Service Division (DDSD) applications.

- The Office of Business Intelligence (OBI), in collaboration with the Probation Department, has developed and finalized a data sharing Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to receive Criminal Offender Record Information (CORI). OBI worked with Probation to securely receive CORI data, and is in the process of conducting the CORI AB 109 population match with HHSa program data. The data analysis related to LIHP benefits accessed by the AB 109 population is targeted for completion in October 2012.
- Health Care Policy Administration conducted site visits and continues to host conference calls with clinics participating in the AuthMed Access Pilot (implemented August 16, 2012) to obtain feedback on the effectiveness of the referral process. A 3 month mid-November evaluation is pending.
- California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) final policy regarding LIHP coverage for State prisoners and local inmates has been received. HHSa has resumed discussions with the Sheriff's Department regarding providing LIHP coverage for local inmates.
- California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) Initial Transition Plan for LIHP has been received. Notification to enrollees and applicants regarding the transition to Affordable Care Act options are to begin in January 2013. DHCS will be providing further instructions, including required language. More details will be provided as they become known.
