Since its introduction, applicants are enjoying the many benefits of the entirely automated application system, one of which is the interest card.

If you know of a job that you would like to apply for but the recruitment just happens to be closed right now, you can submit an interest card for that job. Once the recruitment opens and the job is listed on the [Job Postings](#) page, the system will send you a reminder e-mail to apply! Pretty neat, huh?

This is great news because it beats having to take the time to check the job postings page every single day, waiting for that recruitment to magically appear. Just be sure to include an email address you check regularly.

To submit an interest card (or several!) today, follow these instructions:

1. Click on the [Job Descriptions and Salaries](#) link. (See the menu to the left of this page)
2. Locate the job that interests you and click on the job title.
3. Click on the "Email me when jobs like this become available" link.
4. Fill in the required information.
5. Click the "Submit Request" button and... voilà! You have successfully submitted your first interest card!
