

## **SHERIFF'S RADIO TRAINEE PERFORMANCE EXAM INFORMATION**

Thank you for your interest in testing to become a Sheriff's Radio Trainee. Please read all of the information and instructions listed below regarding the performance exam.

### **Computer Based Examination (Test)**

The examination is entirely computer-based and measures skills that are essential to the job. The examination involves the use of a computer keyboard and mouse. Sorry, there are no practice test materials available to help you prepare.

### **WHAT WILL BE NEEDED TO TAKE THE TEST:**

You need to bring in TWO things to the test.

1. A printed copy of your test notice
2. A form of valid government issued photo identification. This can be a state issued driver's license, state issued identification card, U.S. military identification card, U.S. passport, etc.

Unfortunately, you will not be able to take the test without both of these items.

Weapons are not allowed within the facility. This includes defensive instruments and tools such as pocket knives, mace, pepper spray, kubatons, etc. Please secure any of these items in your vehicle. You will not be permitted to enter the facility at your scheduled time if you are in possession of any of these types of items.

### **LOCATION:**

The entrance to the County of San Diego Operations Center located at the corner of Complex St and Topaz Way in San Diego. Directions are as follows:

From Interstate 163, exit Clairemont Mesa Blvd. and travel east. From Interstate 15, exit Clairemont Mesa Blvd. and travel west. Continue straight on Clairemont Mesa Blvd. to Complex St. Turn north on Complex St. to Topaz Way.

The entrance is the gate to the San Diego County Operations Center where Complex St. and Topaz Way meet.

### **TEST TIME and OTHER INFORMATION:**

It is suggested applicants arrive at the gate 15 minutes before their scheduled test time. Testing will begin promptly at the scheduled time. Late arrivals will not be allowed to test.

Plan on spending up to three (3) hours from the scheduled time for the entire testing process.

Anyone showing up late or not showing up for their assigned test time will be moved to the back of our priority list and is not guaranteed another test date and time.

If you need to reschedule or need to cancel your test time, you may do so up to 1 week before the test date. If you do so after that date, unfortunately, you are not guaranteed another test date and time due to the large number of applicants and limited number of test seats available.

\*\*\* **PLEASE NOTE:** Typically at each exam session we have empty seats that we can fill with stand-by candidates. Candidates who have self-scheduled for the “**STANDBY LIST**” will be granted access to the exam in order of application received date. However, **STANDBY LIST SEATS ARE SUBJECT TO AVAILABILITY AND NOT GUARANTEED.**
