

The San Diego County Library and the Friends of the Ramona Library are proud to celebrate the groundbreaking of the new library, measuring 20,894 square feet, more than four times the size of the current facility. Construction by the design-build team of C.W. Driver, Ferguson Pape Baldwin Architects and Manuel Oncina Architects, is estimated to begin in December, 2009, with a targeted completion date of December, 2010. During this time, library services will continue in the current facility at 1406 Montecito Road. Designed to LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) "Gold" criteria, the state-of-the-art library will include a spacious community room, study rooms, dedicated teen space, a larger children's area with a homework center, a larger number of public computers, a Friends of the Library bookstore, and more.
