Marjorie Hart was born April 15, 1924 in Story City Iowa, graduated from University of Iowa, and became a faculty member at DePauw University in Indiana. She married Dr. William Hart, who established a dental practice in Del Mar and San Diego. They had four children and nine grandchildren.

Professionally, Marjorie Hart was a cellist with the San Diego Symphony and San Diego Opera, continued her education and received a Master's degree at SDSU. She joined the faculty at the University of San Diego, became chairman of the Fine Arts Department and retired, Professor Emeritus.
