Tuesday, September 1st – 6 PM: Noche de la Familia with Author Mateo Camarillo

Meet local author Mateo Camarillo. He is the author of "An immigrant's journey in search of the American Dream". In his memoir, Camarillo details his early life in Tijuana and San Diego, his college years at San Diego State University, his time at the Chicano Federation, and his civic participation and business career. He will give a presentation and Powerpoint about his life. Mateo is from humble beginnings – raised in a cardboard box in Tijuana. He immigrated to the United States as a young man, earned a college degree and went on to become a community organizer, social activist and businessman. As a business-owner, he opened his first McDonald's franchise in Linda Vista in 1976, he owned six Spanish-language radio stations, and most recently he owns All Amigos Ignition Interlock. He was also an advisor to President Gerald Ford. We also will have some story time and crafts for the children - light refreshments will be served and since school starts again soon, the library will provide school supplies as long as supplies last.

Thursday, September 10th – 3 PM: Got Rats? We got answers!

Instead of sleeping, you lie awake, listening to the ghosts in your attic. You hear thumps, thuds, screeches, and scratches -- after a while, the scurrying begins to sound real. You might have them - Roof rats, they're called. And, as you soon learn, roof rats can be dangerous. Hundreds of years ago, rats carried the bubonic plague across Europe. Today's rats carry pathogens in their urine, droppings, blood, and saliva and spread salmonella, typhus, rat-bite fever, hantavirus pulmonary syndrome, and other life-threatening diseases. And rats can be maddeningly difficult to avoid, and even harder to get rid of. Mayra Fernandez from the County Vector Control Team speaks about how to manage rat problems.

Saturday, September 19th – 2 PM - Film Screening: *The Ghost Mountain Experiment*

Join us for a free screening of the "great lost episode" of Huell Howser's acclaimed California's Gold TV series. A Q&A with the director and writer will follow the screening. Back in 2010, the late, great television personality Huell Howser telephoned filmmaker John McDonald and made an unprecedented request. He had seen McDonald's documentary *The Ghost Mountain Experiment*, a story about a family who lived off the grid for 17 years in San Diego County's Anza-Borrego Desert, and wanted to include it in his California's Gold series. Huell found the story of the South family to be a quintessential California story. But the episode was never broadcast when California's Gold became the victim of restructuring within PBS and its famous host decided to retire. Not long before his untimely death, Howser gave his unedited video master of the episode to McDonald in a kind gesture of appreciation. The film features archived family photos, reenactments, and interviews with two of the South children, local historians and South's own writings. Shot over a 15-month period, cinematographer Stuart Asbjornsen's footage brings Ghost Mountain's history to life with breathtaking imagery of the desert throughout the seasons.
