Description of Project:

This project will fund the acquisition cost of a Digital Hand Held Video Receiver for the Sheriff's Alpine Station for use in emergency response and critical incident management in the area of the Viejas Casino.

The Sheriff's Alpine Station covers the unincorporated communities of Alpine, Crest, Dehesa, Blossom Valley, Flinn Springs, Harbison Canyon, and the Viejas and Sycuan Indian Reservations. The Viejas Casino and Outlet Center holds special events which include concerts, parties, gaming contest and events, firework displays, community appreciation gatherings, New Year's Eve parties, and tribal events. Approximately 10,000 persons visit the casino daily.

Currently, the Alpine Sheriff's Station does not have a Digital Hand Held Video Receiver system assigned to their station. The system provides seamless integration of video situational awareness to a first responder patrol deputy. The downlink system provides real-time aerial video from a helicopter (ASTREA) to staff on the ground. This system can be used to quickly assess tactical situations, identify hazards, secure perimeters, locate residences, locate missing persons and direct emergency personnel into an area they may be unfamiliar with.

The downlink system provides a clear picture, and technology allows helicopter staff to zoom in on targets for those on the ground to see. The system is of particular relevance to wildfire evacuations or similar event when a large group of people need to be directed out of or away from an unsafe area. The system will assist first responding deputies to manage large-scale and critical incidents until additional staffing arrives to the area of the casino.

Cost of Project:

The vendor, Vislink, has provided a special law enforcement use discount rate. The acquisition cost for one Digital Hand Held Video Receiver (\$17,687.50), including sales tax (\$1,370.78) and ISF fee of 2.54% (\$484.08), is \$19,542.36.




