General Plan Update

April 13th Board of Supervisors Hearing Minute Order Now Available

The April 13, 2011 Board of Supervisors Hearing Minute Order is now available for viewing on the [General Plan Update website](#). Pursuant to the Board's direction, a number of changes are being incorporated into the General Plan Update and staff is preparing final documents on the update for approval by the Board at a hearing on August 3, 2011.

Policy and Ordinance Development

May 20th - Planning Commission to Receive Options for Updating Equine Regulations

On March 2, 2011, the Board of Supervisors directed staff to work with the equine community and other interested parties to investigate options that would protect and promote horse-related operations within the unincorporated County. DPLU will report back to the Board within 120 days to discuss various options, including the possible creation of a tiered equine ordinance and other applicable ordinance changes. But first, staff will present the proposed options to the Planning Commission for their consideration and recommendations to the Board. The proposed Equine Regulation amendments will be presented to the Planning Commission at the May 20 hearing. May 20th - Status Report on FCI General Plan Amendments to be Presented to Planning Commission

The Forest Conservation Initiative (FCI) is a voter approved initiative which, among other things, set a minimum lot size of 40 acres for approximately 70,000 acres of private lands within the Cleveland National Forest in the County of San Diego. The FCI was originally approved in 1993 and expired on December 31, 2010, at which time these lands reverted to the General Plan designations that were in effect before FCI was approved. The Planning Commission will be provided an update on the Department of Planning and Land Use work plan and process for consideration of a General Plan Amendment to previously designated FCI lands to the Planning Commission on May 20.
