Local Park Recommendations

Current County Target – 15 acres/1000 people  
Steering Committee – 6.5 acres/1000 people  
Interest group – 10.5 acres/1000 population

Regional Park Recommendations

Current County Target – 15 acres/1000 people  
Steering Committee – 15 acres/1000 people  
Interest group – **No consensus**

Current park standard is not met because it is a target and not a standard. The new general plan will be a standard, and therefore guarantee that parks are built.

The density based planning system is a predictable model for future parks. After GP 2020 is completed, the county will have an approximation of how where and how many parks will be built in new development.

A parks standard needs to be set accordingly with the type of quality of life that is desired for the San Diego County residents. The County is responsible for making sure financing does not prevent park development. (Lowering the park standard is also lowering the standard of living for county residents.)

The county of San Diego has appropriated public money to parks because they are an essential part of the county. Parks are another public facility that will be maintained by the county.

Currently there is no county park that meets the existing park target.

### **Density Categories:**

Category “titles” were discussed because they do not provide a good representation of the actual community.

Category titles have been set and approved by the steering committee and the communities.

Further discussion will take place at next meeting. Send out the letter from the Endangered Habitat League prior to the next meeting.

### **Alternative 3 Maps:**

The current Alternative 3 maps have been co-designed by DPLU and by the representing communities. There is some concern on the lack of greenbelt features of the current design.
