## **COUNTY NAMES NEW DEPUTY CHIEF PROBATION OFFICER** *Appointee Has Served the Department for 18 Years*

Chief Probation Officer Mack Jenkins announced the selection of Kim Broderick to the position of Deputy Chief Probation Officer for the County of San Diego Probation Department.

“Ms. Broderick has outstanding credentials and strong leadership skills,” said Chief Jenkins.

“In addition to management experience, she has distinguished herself as a community leader, establishing strong relationships with community-based organizations, the Court, and fellow law enforcement agencies.”

Ms. Broderick has served as the Director of the Community Partnerships and Planning Division since 2002, overseeing a staff of 70 and a budget of \$8.5 million. Broderick began her career with the Department in 1990 after graduating from Duquesne University with a Master’s Degree in Social and Public Policy. Over her 18 year career, Broderick has worked with adults and juveniles, working her way up from line staff to management positions.

In her new capacity, Broderick will lead Adult Field Services, which is responsible for managing the cases of about 19,000 adult probationers who are living in San Diego County. She is taking the reigns from John Hensley, who was appointed Assistant Chief Probation Officer in July.
