United States Border Patrol
First Amendment to Non-Aviation Lease

BACKGROUND

The Border Patrol has had a lease on the Northeast corner of Gillespie Field for a number of years. The Border Patrol continues to use the facility as a vehicle storage and maintenance facility. On June 20th, 2007, the County Board of Supervisors, after recommendation from the Gillespie Field Development Council, approved a new lease with the Border Patrol. The legal staff of Customs and Border Protection (CBP) along with The Department of Homeland Security have determined that they will need a change in order to meet their criteria and legal permissibility and has requested the County execute following amendment.

PROPOSAL

Proposed 1st Amendment change of terms for United States Border Patrol (Current Contract Nos. 71919R)

1.7 Term - The Amendment will reflect a change of term to a two-year base term and four one year options.

1.9 Availability of Funds – The Federal Government's obligation of performance is contingent upon the availability of appropriated funds from which payment for contract purposes can be made.
