Dear Community Member:

State law (Air Toxics "Hot Spots" Information and Assessment Act of 1987) ensures your right to know about possible health risks from toxic air contaminants emitted by sources of air pollution in your neighborhood. The San Diego County Air Pollution Control District (APCD) is the local government agency responsible for implementing this requirement in State law.

The following facility is required to notify all community members in the area where there is a potential health risk above thresholds established by the APCD:

Facility Name: Naval Air Station North Island  
Address: NAS North Island, Coronado, CA  
Type of Business: Military Operation

Based on air emissions data in 2005 the APCD requested a health risk assessment from Naval Air Station North Island. The health risk assessment, approved by the APCD in October 2009, shows that some toxic air contaminants, primarily benzene, polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs), and hexavalent chromium from Naval Air Station North Island may be increasing the cancer risks for people who live in the area. Assuming the facility's emissions in 2005 persisted for 30 years, for people living closest to the facility, their chances of getting cancer could increase to 14 chances in one million. APCD Rule 1210 requires public notification when the cancer risk is above 10 in one million.

The APCD has prepared the enclosed "Program Fact Sheet" regarding its Air Toxic Hot Spots Program and a survey card to obtain your questions and comments regarding the information provided in this notice.
