Meeting Notes Summary

June 2, 2020

1. Welcome & Introductions, All
2. Discussion on CERP Subcommittee Meeting Frequency, All
 - The subcommittee will continue to meet through August 2020, two times per month.
 - Different meeting times could be considered to accommodate schedules (e.g. an afternoon or morning meeting to replace one of the evening meetings).
 - A draft CERP will be presented to the CERP subcommittee in August.
3. Overview of Community Emissions Reduction Plans by Jim Swaney, APCD
 - Source attribution report will be available in late July. This data will demonstrate where pollutants are originating in AB617 communities.
 - Currently available data demonstrates diesel PM as the pollutant of concern.
4. Goals of the CERP Subcommittee, All
 - Provide input on AB617 engagement/outreach work.
 - Make recommendations on stakeholders to engage with (e.g. resident organizations, business and industry sectors, etc.)
 - Conduct initial review of CERP data (e.g. metals, all emissions and how they rank in overall impact) prior to presenting to the AB617 steering committee.
 - Provide feedback to the APCD and AB617 steering committee - what does the community see as the primary concern. Review the public feedback and understand what the health impacts are.
 - Develop/Propose/Review mitigation/emission reduction and exposure reduction actions.
 - Conduct initial review and provide comments on AB617 application before it is presented to the AB617 steering committee.
 - Recommend additional sources of data that could be applicable to the CERP (e.g. health data).
