3. Students must live in San Diego County.
4. Submit artwork along with this completed entry form.
5. Do not fold or staple artwork.
6. Ensure artwork is submitted by November 2, 2018.

Rules: Limit one entry per person, in grade K-12. No responsibility is assumed by SDAPCD for lost, late, illegible, incomplete, stolen, postage due or misdirected entries or mail. Finalists will be picked by a panel of judges from SDAPCD. All entry materials become the exclusive property of SDAPCD and will not be returned.
