NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE, pursuant to State of California Health and Safety Code Section 44363, is hereby given of a public hearing on January 24, 2018, at 9:00 a.m., before the Air Pollution Control Board (Board) of the County of San Diego, in Room 310, County Administration Center, 1600 Pacific Highway, San Diego, California, for the purpose of discussing and receiving public comments on the 2016 Air Toxics "Hot Spots" Program Report for San Diego County.

The California Air Toxics "Hot Spots" Information and Assessment Act was enacted by the Legislature in 1987. It requires facilities to quantify emissions of toxic air contaminants, conduct a public health risk assessment for emissions of concern, and notify the affected public if there is a significant health risk. The Air Pollution Control District is the implementing agency for San Diego County and is required to publish an annual report summarizing program efforts and results. The Air Pollution Control Board will hold a public hearing on the report to discuss its findings.

Written comments on the report are invited. Comments may be submitted no later than one week before the hearing date, and should be addressed to:
