NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE, pursuant to the State of California Health and Safety Code Section 40725 and the Code of Federal Regulations Title 40 Section 51.102, is hereby given of a public hearing on June 26, 2019, at 9:00 a.m., before the Air Pollution Control Board of the County of San Diego, in Room 310, County Administration Center, 1600 Pacific Highway, San Diego, California, for the purpose of receiving public comments on and considering adoption of proposed amendments to New Source Review (NSR) Rule 20.1 – General Provisions, Rule 20.2 – Non-Major Stationary Sources, Rule 20.3 – Major Stationary Sources and PSD Stationary Sources and Rule 20.4 – Portable Emission Units, Rule 26.0 – Banking of Emission Reduction Credits-General Requirements and Rule 1415 – Permit Process-Public Notification. Rules 20.1, 20.2, 20.3 and 20.4 regulate emissions of air contaminants from new and modified facilities requiring permits from the Air Pollution Control District, Rule 26.0 regulates the issuance of Emission Reduction Credits, and Rule 1415 describes the public notification process for federally mandated operating permits.

The proposed rules would correct two U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)-identified deficiencies in the NSR rules amended in 2016, require electronic public notifications of permitting and emission reduction credit actions in addition to newspaper notifications, add the federally mandated applicability thresholds and requirements for each ozone non-attainment classification to the NSR rules, and preserve the allowances for interpollutant offsets on a case-by-case basis.

The proposed amendments incorporate federal and State requirements and will be submitted to the California Air Resources Board and the EPA for approval. The proposed amendments to Rules 20.1, 20.2, 20.3, 20.4 and 1415 will become effective upon approval by the EPA. The proposed amendments to Rule 26.0 will become effective upon adoption by the San Diego Air Pollution Control Board.

A written analysis comparing the proposed amended rules with applicable requirements of federal and local regulations was prepared pursuant to State law and is available upon request.

The Board may consider modifications to the proposal, which may be deemed appropriate. Written comments are also invited. Comments should be addressed to:
