**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**NOTICE**, pursuant to State of California Health and Safety Code Sections 40725 and 42311, is hereby given of a public hearing on April 10, 2019, at 9:00 a.m., before the Air Pollution Control Board (Board) of the County of San Diego, in Room 310, County Administration Center, 1600 Pacific Highway, San Diego, California, for the purpose of receiving public comments on and considering the adoption of proposed amendments to Rule 40 – Permit and Other Fees and Rule 42 – Hearing Board Fees of the San Diego County Air Pollution Control District (District).

Federal law requires the District to adopt fees to recover the full cost of issuing federally mandated permits to major stationary sources of air pollutant emissions. State law authorizes the District to adopt fees to recover the full costs of District programs related to stationary sources that are not otherwise funded, provided total permit fee revenues (collected from all permit fees) do not increase by more than 15%. Board policy requires the District to recover the full cost of fee-supported services.

The proposal meets those requirements and is the result of a comprehensive analysis of District services provided to business customers and the costs to provide those services. The results indicate a fee adjustment is necessary to maintain compliance with cost recovery requirements in Fiscal Year 2019-20.

If adopted, the proposed amendments to Rules 40 and 42 will take effect on July 1, 2019, and are projected to increase the District's total annual fee revenue by \$314,000 (3%).

The Board may consider modifications to the proposal, which may be deemed appropriate. Written comments are also invited. Comments should be addressed to:
