Having read over the proposed changes for Rule 1210, I have comments in two areas.

ONE:
I support the proposed change in the Significant Risk Threshold for maximum individual cancer risks to 10 in one million (from 100 in one million). This stricter limit will hold businesses to a higher standard of air quality control. I would prefer to see an even stricter limit of 1 in one million.

TWO:
The proposed draft puts a cap on changes that businesses must make to reduce pollution if the changes are not "Economically Practicable." I disagree with limiting a business' obligation to operate responsibly regarding air quality control.

The purpose of air quality regulations and the purpose of the APCD is to protect the public, not to protect the profits of businesses.
