Have you wondered how we know the value of agriculture in San Diego county is \$1.77 billion or that over 200 different crops are grown in the county? This information comes directly from producers like you! The Agriculture, Weights and Measures department conducts an annual Crop Report Questionnaire to accurately determine the overall value of agriculture in San Diego county. In fact, this questionnaire is the sole source of information for some of the products listed in our crop report.

The information collected by the Crop Report Questionnaire is critical because it helps guide policymakers regarding agriculture and provides researchers with reliable and statistical information regarding the volume and variety of crop commodities. Grower participation educates the public on the importance of agriculture in our local economy. The Crop Report Questionnaire also determines where San Diego county ranks among counties in California and nation in agricultural production.

Your support in completing the 2019 San Diego County Crop Report Questionnaire is critical to its success. Please keep in mind, the more growers returning a completed questionnaire - the greater the accuracy of the Crop Report for San Diego county. It is important to provide gross values for all commodities grown in 2019 on the Crop Report Questionnaire.

The commodity values shared are anonymous, as we only ask that your zip code be provided. The Crop Report Questionnaire is kept confidential and will be used solely for the purpose of compiling relevant annual commodity statistics, and will be unavailable to any other agency.

Please complete and return only one questionnaire. Please, if you are no longer in business, but grew crops in San Diego in 2019, still report your crop values for the year. Disregard this questionnaire if you already completed one for 2019. The 2019 Crop Report Questionnaire can also be downloaded from our website at www.sdcawm.org.

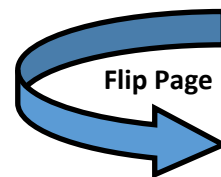

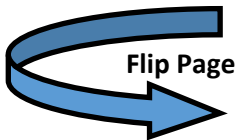
