


Annual savings of \$2,400

Tier 3: 10+ scanners (405 businesses)	\$272	\$274	\$2	1%	
Reinspection Hourly Rate	\$168	\$172	\$4	2%	
Total additional revenue \$10K annually




Tier 1 includes 2,958 registrants or about 66% of the total businesses in the program
