Things to Know About Live Bee Removal

- 1. Live bee removal is the process of removing live bees humanely without pesticides.
- 2. Live bee removal specialists are experienced beekeepers who can humanely remove and relocate bees to a registered apiary to ensure they don't return to your property.
- 3. Property owners are responsible for safely removing bees on their property.
- 4. Prevent honeybee swarms by removing hollow dead trees and sealing up all openings into attics, crawlspaces, and siding larger than 1/8-inch. All vents should have 1/8-inch screening.
- 5. Do not ever try to remove bees
 yourself or spray them with water or
 pesticides. Contact an experienced live
 bee removal service or licensed pest
 control business.
