

Citrus Pest and Disease Prevention Division (CPDPD) Activities

- Multi-Pest Survey: Field staff visit residential properties to look for citrus pests/diseases and take plant/insect samples.
- Commodity Survey: Field staff visit citrus groves to look for citrus pests/diseases and take plant/insect samples.
- Delimitation Survey/Treatment: 250-meter Survey/Treatment area around CLas positive ACP and HLB positive tree find sites.
- Regulatory: Conduct regulatory activities in the ACP/HLB quarantine areas.
- Biocontrol: Release Tamarixia wasps around HLB delimitation areas and high-risk areas.

Recent HLB Finds

Area: Valley Center 8

- Detected 3/7/25
- Two trees were treated and removed.

Area: Valley Center 9

- Detected 3/14/25
- 5 miles North of VC 8
- One tree was treated and removed.

Delimitation Status

Delimitation Area:

250-meter radius around each findsite.

HLB Trees Detected:

3 trees were treated and removed.

Delimitation Survey:


- Survey is ongoing

250 m Treatment Area




Notification Area




