- HDPE embossed with the plastic resin code #2
- EPA registered product containers
- Containers up to 55 gallons.

Containers will be inspected. Any container not properly rinsed, drained and punctured will be rejected. After inspection, customers must move containers to the dumpster. Due to liability issues, county staff will not be removing the containers from vehicles.

- Dry
- Caps removed
- Labeling removed
- CUT in quarters

if larger than 15 gallons

Not accepted:

- Hazardous Materials
- Caps, metal handles, and rubber linings; all NON-HDPE parts
- Fertilizer, veterinary, swimming pool, consumer, or home & garden containers
- Motor oil, fuel, or antifreeze containers
- PVC pipe, plastic tubing, greenhouse plastic.
