Bee gardening tips:

- Plant for year-round, overlapping bloom
- Include a mix of plant families, flower shapes, flower sizes, and flower colors
- Plant in patches of one species
- Pollen and nectar are needed at all times, but pollen is especially important in the spring and nectar is especially important in the fall
- Mind the mulch! Leave some bare soil for ground-nesting bees.
- Provide a shallow water source with drinking perches
