OVERVIEW AND PURPOSE



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MEDI-CAL RX: TRANSITION

- Transition date is January 1, 2022
- Standardize Medi-Cal benefits
- Outpatient Drugs, Pharmacy Reimbursable Physician Administered Drugs (PADs), Specific Medical Supplies, Enteral Nutrition Products
- Increase Access to pharmacy services/network
 - Consistency
 - All Medi-Cal pharmacies are in-network

CONSUMER/PHARMACY BENEFITS



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MEDI-CAL RX

Includes:

- Medi-Cal Managed Care
- Medi-Cal FFS
- California Children's Services (CCS)
- Family Planning, Access, Care and Treatment (FPACT)

Excludes:

- Senior Care Action Network (SCAN)
- Cal MediConnect
- Major Risk Medical Insurance Program (MRMIP)
- Programs of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE)

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MEDI-CAL RX

- Managed Care Plan (MCP) cards and ID numbers cannot be used
- 180 Day transition period
- Confirmation of Medi-Cal eligibility
- Benefit Identification Card (BIC) and CIN Cards
- Medi-Cal Enrollment 1-866-252-1949
- Appeals and Assistance
