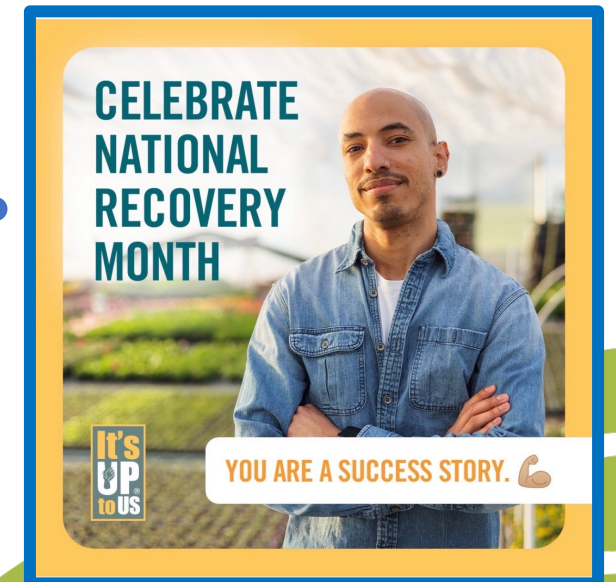

CONTRACT AMENDMENT TO SUPPORT CARE ACT IMPLEMENTATION



Independent Living Association & Recovery Residence Association

- Amend the contract to increase funding to \$4,773,348
- Supports the implementation of CARE Act
- Addresses the needs of those with serious mental illness who have a court-ordered CARE Plan



Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System (DMC-ODS)



Execute DMC-ODS Intergovernmental Agreement from the State of California and Accept Funding

- DMC-ODS provides a continuum of care for evidence-based substance use disorder treatment services
- Since implementation in 2018, DMC-ODS has enabled more local control and accountability, greater administrative oversight, improved care and efficiency
- This action will renew the DMC-ODS agreement and result in revised revenues of \$684.8 million in FY 2023-24 through 2026-27

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
