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1. SUBJECT: APPROVE THE RECOGNIZED OBLIGATION PAYMENT SCHEDULE FOR JULY 2018 - JUNE 2019 AND ADMINISTRATIVE BUDGET (DISTRICTS: ALL)

OVERVIEW

On January 24, 2012 (14), the County of San Diego was designated as the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the County of San Diego (Successor Agency) to oversee the wind-down of the former redevelopment agency's operations following the steps established by ABX1 26 and AB 1484, collectively known as the Dissolution Act, which include preserving assets, fulfilling legally binding commitments, overseeing the termination of activities, and returning resources expeditiously to the affected taxing entities. The Redevelopment Agency of the County of San Diego was dissolved on February 1, 2012.

The Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule (ROPS) is the report that authorizes the amount of former redevelopment agency property tax increment to be allocated to the Successor Agency for payment of Enforceable Obligations. The County Successor Agency is required to submit the ROPS and the administrative budget annually to the County Oversight Board.

Approval of the ROPS for July 2018 - June 2019 (ROPS 18-19) and the related administrative budget for the same period is requested. Total enforceable obligations of \$2,240,181 are eligible to be funded, including the Gillespie Field 2005 Bond Turbo Redemption payment of \$320,000 and an administrative budget of \$30,000. If approved, both items will be presented to the County Oversight Board on January 18, 2018 for approval. The Oversight Board approved ROPS will be subsequently transmitted to the State Department of Finance before the deadline of February 1, 2018. The ROPS 18-19, as with all ROPS, may be changed by the County Oversight Board or the Department of Finance.

RECOMMENDATION(S)

CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER

1. Approve the Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule for July 2018 - June 2019 (ROPS 18-19) and authorize staff to make any non-substantive changes to the ROPS to comply with the Department of Finance's requirements for submittal.
2. Approve the administrative budget for July 2018 - June 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT

The payments shown on the Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule for July 2018 - June 2019 will be included in the Fiscal Year 2018-19 Operational Plan for the Successor Agency. The funding source is property tax increment distributed from the Redevelopment Property Tax Trust Fund.
