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**1. SUBJECT: SAN DIEGO COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT (SDCFPD)
FIRE ADVISORY BOARD BYLAWS (DISTRICTS: ALL)**

OVERVIEW

On October 21, 2014 (1), the San Diego County Board of Supervisors authorized the formation of an advisory board to provide input on the provision of fire protection and emergency medical services throughout the county of San Diego.

Pursuant to Board of Supervisors Policy A-74, Citizen Participation in County Boards, Commissions and Committees, today's action requests the San Diego County Fire Protection District Board of Directors approve the proposed SDCFPD Fire Advisory Board bylaws.

Approve the bylaws for the San Diego County Fire Protection District Fire Advisory Board as required by Board Policy A-74.

EQUITY IMPACT STATEMENT

More than 80 percent of the San Diego County Fire Protection District's (SDCFPD) jurisdictional area qualifies as a disadvantaged unincorporated community, based on a San Diego Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) report on the funding, administration, and performance of the former County Service Area No. 135 (now SDCFPD). Today's proposed action to approve the SDCFPD Fire Advisory Board bylaws will continue the public forum for citizens within these communities to provide feedback on the delivery of fire protection and emergency medical services. In addition, the proposed bylaws expand the Fire Advisory Board's membership by adding one representative each from Supervisorial Districts Three and Four, which will broaden Countywide participation and input on the provisions of these services throughout the region.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action. There will be no change in net General Fund cost and no additional staff years will be required.
