Resolution No. 20 -054 Establishing the Commission

Each Commission nomination shall . . . attempt to nominate members of the community to create a Commission that is

- reflective of the demographics, diversity, and culture of San Diego County,
- including, comprehensive representation of age, gender, socioeconomic status, ethnic background, culture, religion, sexual orientation, and geographical distribution, and,
- consider the prospective Commissioner's knowledge and awareness of the problems and causes of intergroup tension and conflict.
- Prospective members shall have demonstrated a commitment to fostering better human relations in San Diego County.

 - Latino
 - Districts 1, 3, and 5
 - Youth
