

Civil Service Commission Meeting Public Participation

You may observe or participate in Civil Service Commission meetings by appearing in-person or online.

If you want to provide oral comments to the Civil Service Commission about an agenda item during the upcoming meeting, please follow the instructions below. This will ensure the Civil Service Commission is aware you wish to speak on that item. At the beginning of the meeting, during Order of Business Items D & E, the Commission President will ask if anyone would like to pull an agenda item for discussion. There will be a total of five minutes for all public input on each of the agenda items unless additional time is granted.

Option 1: In-Person

Attend the meeting in-person at the meeting location: County Administration Center, 1600 Pacific Highway, 4th Floor, Room 402A, San Diego, California. Free parking is available at the underground garage off Ash Street, between Pacific Highway and Harbor Drive.

Option 2: Join the meeting using Zoom

A few minutes before the meeting is scheduled to start, follow the link on the agenda and join the webinar using the Zoom application (recommended) or a web browser.

Use the "Q&A" function located at the bottom of the screen to inform the Commission of your intent to speak about an agenda item. Please include your name, telephone number, or other identifying feature you selected when logging in, and the agenda item number you want to speak about. **If you are an appellant or employee with an item on the agenda you want to pull for discussion, it's recommended that you change your display name on Zoom to the number we assigned you, for example "2024-001".** Commission staff will note this information and at the appropriate time your microphone will be unmuted, and you will have an opportunity to speak.

Option 3: Dial into the meeting (not using Zoom app)

A few minutes before the meeting is scheduled to start, call the "Attendee" phone number listed on the agenda, enter the Webinar ID and passcode. Your phone will be automatically muted. Use the "Raise Hand" function by pressing *9 to alert Commission staff of your intent to speak about an agenda item. You will be asked to unmute your phone (by pressing *6), and to announce your name (or number you were assigned), the last four digits of your phone number and the agenda item number you want to speak about. Commission staff will note this information. At the appropriate time you will have an opportunity to speak.
