The Sheriff's Department welcomes and supports the Citizens' Law Enforcement Review Board's (CLERB) independent review of complaints alleging improper actions by members of this organization and in-custody deaths. We continuously strive to respond with professionalism and concern to the citizens we serve, and the CLERB process provides invaluable input.

On May 12, 2023, CLERB recommended the following:

1. CLERB recommends the San Diego Sheriff's Department (SDSD) create a Training Bulletin on the subject of handicap parking law enforcement, including but not limited to temporary and permanent placards and parking restrictions, for distribution to all patrol deputies.

On January 10, 2023, the San Diego Sheriff's Department In-Service Training Unit disseminated the Disabled License Plates and Placard training Bulletin to all San Diego Sheriff's Law Enforcement.
