- Roll Call** ▪ The Board meeting was held at the County Administration Center and came to order at 5:30 p.m. All Board members were present except Gary Brown and Loren Vinson.

- New Business** ▪ Status of Sheriff's Department use of body-worn cameras: Sheriff's Liaison, Robert Kanaski, reported that the procurement of body-worn cameras is still in progress, and the Sheriff's Department is already working on draft policies and procedures. The department is still considering when deputies will be authorized to review body-worn camera video.

 - Riley Gordon – There is a lot of disagreement to see what officers should see what's on the camera before they write a report. Do you have any sense on where the policy is on that issue?
