# VICE CHAIR MONTGOMERY STEPPE TO ANNOUNCE UPDATES ON LAW ENFORCEMENT OVERSIGHT AND JUVENILE JUSTICE REFORM

**SAN DIEGO, CA** — On Monday, August 25<sup>th</sup>, Vice Chair Monica Montgomery Steppe will hold a press briefing to announce a series of proposed policy initiatives aimed at strengthening transparency, accountability, and conditions within San Diego County's law enforcement and juvenile justice systems.

The announcement follows recent reports and ongoing investigations that have highlighted systemic concerns within County detention facilities, including the excessive use of chemical agents on youth, limited investigatory authority in cases of in-custody deaths, and an overall lack of meaningful public oversight.

Vice Chair Montgomery Steppe will outline key reform proposals ahead of the Board of Supervisors' upcoming meeting, including:

- Phasing out the **use of all chemical agents**, including OC (Oleoresin Capsicum) spray, in youth detention centers
- De-emphasizing the use of **room/solitary confinement** in youth facilities
- Requiring trauma-informed de-escalation training for all probation officers working with youth
- Updates to expanding the **investigatory authority** of the Citizens' Law Enforcement Review Board (CLERB)

# CLERB,

I asked one of the county's supervisors of facility maintenance/projects for the below information. Not all the intercom systems are the same, and vary in different aspects including, but not limited to, age, functions/log capabilities, and manufacturer.

- Each facility-specific system (manufacturer, provider, system name)
   SDCJ, LCDRF, EMDRF,GBDF, RMDF Black Creek Integration Systems (BCIS)
   SBDF, VDF Stetofon and programmed by a small company, SST
- Can the intercoms be turned off in individual cells
   No.
- Can the intercoms be silenced or placed on stand-by mode
   The systems themselves are not designed to be silenced.
- Does the cell intercom system have volume settings
   Yes, the Deputy can control the volume of the of the person talking on the other end.
- Can the volume setting be muted
   The systems themselves are not designed to be muted.
- Is there an audible notification to sworn staff when an intercom speaker is activated in a cell

Yes.

- What are the decibels the audible notification is set to
   It is adjustable and varies but does not go to no sound at all. We have no exact information on decibels.
- Are there any other notifications when a cell intercom is activated (light, screen pop-up, chirp, vibration, etc)
  - For the SST panels, a cell intercom light comes on and an audible sound is made when the button is pushed inside the cell. The light stays on until answered (by a deputy) and then the light goes out. On BCIS, the initial visual and audible notifications are the same. However, the light continues to blink and an audible continues until answered.
- Are any of the intercom systems outfitted with recording capabilities

Our systems cannot record audio.

- Do any of the intercom systems have activation log capabilities
   The newer BCIS systems at LCDRF, GBDF, RMDF are capable of recording times
   and durations of buttons pushed by the cell and the user. The SST panels do not.
- Who services the intercom systems (speakers, computer system, cell intercoms)
   Sheriff facilities staff and a contracted BCIS employee.
- How often are they serviced
   As needed, daily work.
- Does DGS keep service records provided to intercom systems at the facilities?
   DGS's Tririga system has records of the reported issues with the intercoms. This does not cover all services or calls for repairs.
