

**NAME:** **COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 138 – VALLEY CENTER  
PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

**LEGAL AUTHORITY:** Resolution No. 21-051 adopted 4/7/2021 (6). The CSA No. 138 Advisory Committee was established in accordance with Board Policies A-74 by Board Orders on 04/07/2021 (6)

**PURPOSE:** This committee is established to encourage public participation in the policies and programs relating to County Service Area No. 138.

The advisory committee is a non-partisan, nonsectarian, non-profit-making organization. It does not take part officially in, nor does it lend its influence on any political issues.

The advisory committee is to advise the County Department of Parks and Recreation and the Board of Supervisors only. The advisory committee is not empowered by ordinance, establishing authority or policy to render a decision of any kind on behalf of the County of San Diego or its appointed or elected officials.

**MEMBERS  
APPOINTED BY:**

Members of the Advisory Board shall be nominated by the Supervisor of District 5 and appointed by the Board of Supervisors.

**MEMBERSHIP  
COMPOSITION:**

Membership of the advisory committee is limited to five (5) committee members who must be a resident of Valley Center, residing within the CSA No.138 boundary.

**TERMS AND  
VACANCIES:**

Terms for the members of the Advisory Board shall run concurrent with the term of the nominating Supervisor.

A committee member shall be removed from the advisory committee after three (3) consecutive unexcused absences or three (3) unexcused absences in a twelve month period.

Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as that position was originally filled.

**DUTIES:** The Advisory Committee is to advise the Department of Parks and Recreation as set forth by Board Policy A-74, and to provide community input on priorities and goals for the CSA No. 138 park facilities.

The Advisory Board shall review and make recommendations on proposed County Ordinances regarding fixing and collecting charges on the tax roll for miscellaneous extended services provided by County Service Area No. 128 - San Miguel Local Park District.

The Advisory Board shall operate in accordance with Board Policy A-74, and A-74a through A-74f, and shall be reviewed for continuance as a part of the regularly scheduled Sunset Review process for County Advisory groups in accordance with Board Policy A-74e, Citizen Advisory Committee Policy on Sunset Review.
