

NAME: **ABANDONED VEHICLE ABATEMENT SERVICE
AUTHORITY, SAN DIEGO**

LEGAL AUTHORITY: California Government Code § 25845 and 38773.5;
California Vehicle Code § 27710; and Board of Supervisors
Resolution No. 19A adopted 3/5/91.

STATUS: The Program is no longer funded by the collection of fees
through vehicle registrations and will cease to exist once all
existing fund balances are expended.

Vehicle Code section 2271(g), states that a service
authority “shall cease to exist on the date that all revenues
received by the authority pursuant to this section and
Section 9250.7 have been expended.”

**MEMBERS
APPOINTED BY &
COMPOSITION:**

The Board of Directors of the San Diego Service Authority
for Freeway Emergencies shall constitute the members of
the San Diego Board of Directors of the San Diego
Abandoned Vehicle Abatement Service Authority.

Two members are selected by the Board of Supervisors and
five members selected jointly by the City Councils of Cities
within the County.

TERMS: Indefinite.

DUTIES: To promote an organized program for the abatement,
removal and disposal of abandoned, wrecked, dismantled,
or inoperative vehicles to protect the health and safety of
citizens.
