

NAME: CITRUS PEST CONTROL DISTRICT, SAN DIEGO COUNTY

LEGAL AUTHORITY: California Food and Agriculture Code, Section 8401-8759

MEMBERS APPOINTED BY: Board of Supervisors

MEMBERSHIP COMPOSITION: The District's Board shall consist of five members who are required to be citizens of the United States, residents of California, and owners of lands that grow commercial citrus in whole or in part within the District.

TERMS: The members of the Districts are nominated and appointed by the Board of Supervisors. Members shall serve for terms of four years and until the appointment and qualification of their successors.

The terms of the members of the first Board appointed by the Board of Supervisors shall divide themselves by lot and one member shall serve for a term of one year, one member shall serve for a term of two years, one member shall serve for a term of three years, and two members shall serve for a term of four years.

Upon the resignation or expiration of the term of any member of the board, the Board of Supervisors shall appoint his/or her successor. Vacancies shall be filled by the Board of Supervisors for the unexpired term.

DUTIES: Eradicate and control certain citrus pests within the designated areas of Pauma Valley, San Pasqual Valley, and Borrego. The District will form a pest management plan, develop and file a budget, and set an assessment in accordance with Proposition 218 rules.

COMPENSATION: The members of the Board are not entitled to any compensation for their services, but may be reimbursed for their actual and necessary expenses, when claims for such expenses have been approved by the Board.
