**MEMBERSHIP
COMPOSITION:**

The Advisory Committee shall consist of one representative each of the following organizations/communities:

- Bostonia Area of San Miguel Fire Protection District
- City of Santee, Two (2) Members
- Grossmont Hospital
- Lakeside Chamber of Commerce
- Lakeside Community Planning Group
- Lakeside Fire Protection District
- Lakeside Union School District Board
- Santee Chamber of Commerce
- Santee School District Board

TERMS: The term of office for each member or alternate shall be at the discretion of the appointing organization.

DUTIES: The duties and responsibilities of the Advisory Committee are as follows:

1. To advise the County Health and Human Services Agency, Emergency Medical Services and the Board of Supervisors on matters relating to standards and levels of ambulance service within County Service Area 69.
2. To make recommendations to the County Health and Human Services Agency and the Board of Supervisors concerning budgetary and contractual matters related to the funding and operation of County Service Area 69.
3. To provide periodic public meetings to receive public input regarding ambulance service levels from the residents provided service in the Heartland Emergency Medical Services District.

4. To review and make recommendations to the County Health and Human Services Agency and Board of Supervisors establishing the levels for benefit taxes and non-resident transport fees.
