CONFLICT OF INTEREST - DESIGNATED PERSONNEL No. 9270
Page 1 of 1

All designated personnel identified in this section, pursuant to the Conflict of Interest Code, shall comply with the requirements of this Code.

The Superintendent will provide the approved forms for use by the designated personnel prior to the filing date. These completed forms are to be returned to the office of the District Superintendent prior to March 15 each year.

New persons to designated positions must complete the filing of the initial disclosure statement at least ten days prior to assuming the designated position unless an emergency circumstance exists. In such case the statement shall be filed within 30 days of the date of assumption of the position.

All designated personnel must file a disclosure statement within 30 days after vacating a designated position.
