The Political Reform Act (Government Code Section 81000, et seq.) requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation (2 California Code of Regulations Section 18730) that contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code, which can be incorporated by reference in an agency's code. After public notice and hearing, the standard code may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act. Therefore, the terms of 2 California Code of Regulations Section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission are hereby incorporated by reference. This regulation and the attached Appendix [or Appendices], designating positions and establishing disclosure categories, shall constitute the conflict of interest code of the **VISTA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT (DISTRICT)**.

Individuals holding designated positions shall file their Statements of Economic Interests (Form 700s) with the **County of San Diego Clerk of the Board of Supervisors**.

Thank you for your call this morning. As discussed, the documents submitted by the Vista Fire Protection District ("VFPD") contain its new Conflict of Interest ("COI") Policy, approved by the Vista Fire Protection District Board, and for which we now seek County approval from the County Board of Supervisors.

The Board elected to create an entirely new policy as the previous policy had not been modified since 1997 and was extremely outdated. Accordingly, the VFPD Board established its new COI policy based on the requirements under the law and approved said policy by a unanimous vote at a properly held meeting.

The VFPD Board believes that its new COI Policy meets all County of San Diego regulations and seeks immediate approval of said policy so it may be implemented immediately.
